

The Convent of the Holy Spint Missionary Sisters complex c onsists of a main and four annex buildings. The Sisters started occupying the Convent in August of 2000. The ma in building prima rily consists of a 2-story structure with ma sonry exterior walls.

Since the initial occupancy of the buildings, several water leakage issues were observed. Overtime, several attempts at solving the reported water leaks had been made by the original general contrac tor. However, many of the leakage issues persisted. BTC was reta ined by the Sisters to evaluate the leaks, develop repair schemes, a nd to perform construction observations. BTC also provided litigation support services.

Evaluation of the exterior walls and windows included a visual review of those components, water testing, exploratory openings, review of design documents, and code review. Water testing successfully reproduced the reported leaks and the exploratory openings revealed several deficiencies in the design and construction of the through-wall fla shings, and installation of the wood frame windows.

In addition to its services related to the exterior walls and windows, BTC worked closely with mechanic al/electrical/ plumbing, and civil consultants to evaluate other design and construction defic iencies in the construction of the development.

BTC assisted the Sisters in negotiations with the Arc hitect-ofRecord and General Contractor to repair orcompensate the Sisters for the defic iencies.
