



## Project Profile



Oakbrook Center is one of the largest open air shopping malls in the Chicago area. In 2001 and 2002, the mall underwent a major enhancement project. The enhancement project included the re-cladding of storefronts, reconstruction and re-cladding of walkway canopies and construction of several new crosswalk canopies made of glass panels.

BTC started assisting the mall Owners and the design architect by evaluating the existing condition of storefront masonry walls and developing repair options to address their deterioration. BTC then continued its services throughout the design phase by assisting the design architect in developing details and specifications for construction of the new canopy roofs and crosswalk canopies.

In addition to the design phase services, BTC also provided construction observations related to the installation of the roofing systems and repair of the masonry storefronts.
